



## IMPF Network Project – Work Package 2

### Summary

IMPF hosted and co-hosted a number of events during 2024 to the benefit of the international, independent music publishing community. Events included the organisation's General Assembly in Dublin, the third Global Music Summit in Palma and a number of other contributions to existing conferences around the world.

### Activity

#### Dublin General Assembly

IMPF hosted its 2024 General Assemblies at the Conrad Dublin Hotel (April 25 – 26). The event saw independent music publisher members and related partners from around the world gather to discuss business and hear from some of the industry's leading figures across a programme of panels and speeches covering a range of topics including generative AI; independent publishers and independent labels; video games and music; diversity and inclusion in the music business; music supervision; creators rights awareness platform CLIP; and the new dot music domain. #### The IMPF Global Music Summit 2024

IMPF's Global Music Summit and Songwriting Camp was hosted for the 3rd time in Palma de Mallorca, extended to four days, from October 01 – 04 2024. The Global IMPF Music Summit has become a must attend meeting for IMPF's music publisher members, songwriters, friends and special guests. ### Who we worked with

The third IMPF Global Music Summit and Songwriting Camp was made possible through co-financing from the EU's Creative Europe Programme, in partnership with 22D Music and Kemper Music Group. It was backed this year by a long list of big-name sponsors, including Roba Music Publishing, TRO Essex Music Group, CTM Publishing, Salt, BumaStemra, Raleigh Music Group, ICE Services, Budde Music, AMRA, Bucks Music Group, Downtown, GC Partners, Mint Services, On Music, Reel Muzik Werks, Reservoir Media, Sacem, Spotify, Oyez! and Session Studio. More than 60 speakers featured on this year's programme of panel sessions, including three heavyweight keynote speakers in Golnar Khosrowshahi (founder and CEO, Reservoir), David Israelite (president and CEO, National Music Publishers' Association), and Mike O'Neill (President and CEO, BMI). Meanwhile, the Palma Songwriting Camp saw 20 writers/artists, selected by a committee, collaborating in groups at Palma Music Studios.

## Beneficiaries

IMPF's Global Music Summit and its concurrent Songwriting Camp have continued to gain influence, exposure and popularity. This is now, without question, a must attend meeting for independent music publishers, songwriters, and industry friends and partners. The 2024 edition was attended by more than 500 music publishing delegates, songwriters and associated interested parties. Meanwhile, The General Assembly is an important, in-person touch point for both IMPF as an organisation and its members.
